Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Wardha-Yavatmal-Nanded broad gauge line of the Central Railways was not approved in the previous budget; and
- (b) if so, the time by which approval to the said line is likely to be accorded?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Wardha-Nanded via Yavatmal-Pusood (284 km) new line project has already been sanctioned in 2008-09 with cost sharing with Government of Maharashtra (Railways 60% & GoM 40%). Latest anticipated cost of the project is ₹3168.29 crore. An expenditure of ₹532.8 crore has been incurred upto March, 2017 and an outlay of ₹238 crore has been provided in 2017-18.
