(a) to (e): As part of the Mumbai Ahmedabad High Speed Railway (MAHSR)

Project, it has been decided to set up a Training Institute at Ahmedabad

area/Gujarat State with the technical and financial assistance of Government of Japan. The Training Institute is an integral part of the project. Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) between the Government of Japan and Government of India signed in December, 2015 envisages training of 4000 officials of High Speed Rail.
