(a) to (e) Yes, Madam. As per survey report, the cost of project of 154.437 km new line was ₹972.92 crore with negative rate of return of 6.42%. The project could not be taken forward as it was financially not viable, poor traffic potential and Railways has already got a large shelf on ongoing projects.
