(a)&(b): The report submitted by the Committee set up under the Chairmanship of Secretary (RTH) was accepted by the Ministry and forwarded to the State Government for taking necessary action. The policy envisages the objective of providing safe and secure public road transport to people of the country, particularly to women and girl child. It also recommended that for the safety of women and child passengers, the central locking system in the taxis should not be allowed. MoRTH has issued notification vide GSR No. 1095(E) dated 28.11.2016 whereby Gol has mandated the provision of vehicle location device and one or more panic button in public transport vehicles w.e.f. April 1st, 2018.
