Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether construction of underpasses, overbridges and widening of roads is going on National Highway in order to solve the problem of traffic and traffic jams across the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether there is a need to construct a road overbridge to solve the problem of traffic jam on a stretch of road from Pandra to Kachahari road, Kachahari Chowk to Daranda via Albertchak Chowk, Albertchak Chowk to Kokar via Lalpur Chowk and Ratu Road to Kachahari Road in Ranchi district, if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereon;
- (c) the number of bridges and roads likely to be completed by the year 2019; and
- (d) the details of the amount likely to be spent thereon?

(a) to (d) Yes Madam. 1457 projects amounting to Rs. 403249 Crores having length 45830 km are ongoing for widening of NHs, underpasses & over bridges and these projects are likely to be completed by Dec 2019. Two stretches from Pandra to Kachahari Road and from Ratu Road to Kachahari Road, lies on NH-75, have been taken up for development and other two stretches are not part of NHs.
