- (a) whether the alertness of two teenagers in Delhi saved the lives of 194 people on board a Bengaluru bound private airline recently as they spotted fire and smoke from the tail of the aircraft;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the flight made the emergency landing and lives of all people on board were saved and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Airports Authority of India has taken any steps to reward these teenagers for their presence of mind displayed; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) to (c) M/s Go Air A-320 aircraft was involved in an incident while operating flight from Delhi to Bengaluru, as immediately after take - off, engine related snag appeared on No. 1 engine, resulting in its auto shut-down. The pilot declared emergency and landed back safely at Delhi. There was no injury to any person.
- (d) & (e) As the Delhi Airport is managed by GMR, Airports Authority of India(AAI) has no role.
