(a) the details of contracts awarded to Brahmaputra Infrastructure Limited for mining of Coal and over-burden in the Bharat Coking Coal Limited area; and

(b) the names of the areas where dumping sites have been allotted to Brahmaputra Infrastructure Limited and the distance of the dumping sites from the mining area?

(a)&(b): Coal India Limited has informed that Brahmaputra Consortium Limited (later name changed to Brahmaputra Infrastructure Limited) was awarded contract for the work of hiring of Heavy Earth Moving Machinery (HEMM) for removal & transportation of Over Burden (OB) and extraction & transportation of coal from XIV/XIII/XII/XI seams of Kankanee Colliery of Sijua Area of Bharat Coking Coal Limited (BCCL) with fire-fighting, wagon loading & rehandling of 2.00 lakh cub. mtr. loose OB for the period of 72 months with financial impact of Rs.286,99,85,010 at diesel base price of Rs.32.89/Ltr. Letter of Acceptance was issued on 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2007.
