**Handloom Sector:**

1. National Handloom Development Programme (with following components)
  - (i) Block Level Cluster
  - (ii) Handloom Marketing Assistance
  - (iii) Concessional credit/weavers Mudra Scheme
  - (iv) Handloom Census
  - (v) Bunkar Mitra
2. Handloom Weavers' Comprehensive Welfare Scheme
3. Yarn Supply Scheme
4. Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme

## Handicraft Sector:

1. National Handicraft Development Programme (with following components)
  - (i) Dastkar Shashtikaran Yojana under Ambedkar Hastshilp Vikas Yajana (AHVY)
  - (ii) Design & Technology Upgradation (DTU)
  - (iii) Human Resource Development (HRD)
  - (iv) Direct Benefit to Artisans (DBT)
  - (v) Infrastructure and Technology Support (ITS)
  - (vi) Research and Development (R&D)
  - (vii) Marketing Support Services (MSS)
  
2. Comprehensive Handicrafts Cluster Development Scheme (with following components)
  - (i) Mega Cluster (MC)
  - (ii) Special projects under Integrated Development and Promotion of Handicrafts (IDPH)

Due to implementation of above schemes, the skill level of the weavers/artisans has improved over the years leading to increase in productivity.

Since Handlooms and Handicrafts are in unorganised sector, data of employment is not centrally available.
