- (b) the number of phases for completion of the said project;
- (c) the details of phases completed till now;
- (d) whether the work scheduled to be completed under the present phase is being unnecessarily delayed and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the reaction of the Government thereto and the steps taken to complete the present phase of the said project?

(a) to (e) Water resources project are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priority. In order to supplement the efforts Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, RD&GR) provides financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes such as Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) etc. under Pradhan Manti Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) as per the guidelines of the scheme.

The project authorities have not obtained requisite statutory clearances and investment clearance. Further, they have intimated that the project is planned as a whole with completion schedule as June, 2021.
