**WIDENING OF ROADS**

4015. SHRI VENKATESH BABU T.G.:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether the Government proposes to widen the highways, peripheral highways and bypass roads around the cities of Chennai and Madurai;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the funds earmarked/allocated/released therefor; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor ?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Seven projects in and around Chennai and two projects in and around Madurai City have been envisaged for development by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). Chennai bypass connecting NH-45, NH-4, NH-205 and NH-5 has already been developed by the NHAI. There is no other proposal for construction of new bypass/ring road for Chennai by the NHAI. However, State Govt. of Tamilnadu envisages construction of Peripheral Ring Road connecting Mahabalipuram to Ennore Port. The construction of Madurai ring road is in DPR stage.
