(a) whether the Government has laid down any directives/parameters for acquisition of land for construction of National Highways and flyovers;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the land acquired by the various States including Uttar Pradesh, for construction of National Highways, State-wise;

(c) the details of the hectares of land acquired in various States during the Twelfth Five Year Plan for the said purpose and the details of the amount given under the compensation package, State/UT-wise;

(d) the current status of the ongoing projects on National Highways No. 233 and 730 in Uttar Pradesh; and

(e) the time by which these projects are likely to be completed?

The land required for the development and maintenance of the National Highway (NH) projects including flyovers, is acquired under the provisions contained in Section 3 of the National Highways (NHs) act, 1956. State wise/year wise details of land acquired by the National Highways Authority of India during the 12th Five Year Plan (i.e. 2012-13 up to 2016-17) is enclosed as Annexure I. State wise/year wise details of compensation paid for land acquired by the National Highways Authority of India during the 12th Five Year Plan (i.e. 2012-13 up to 2016-17) are enclosed as Annexure II.

(d) and (e) Current Status of the ongoing projects on National Highways Nos. 233 and 730 are enclosed as Annexure III and Annexure-IV respectively.
