- (a) whether Air India (AI) has drawn up a proposal to offer Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) to around 15,000 employees before the disinvestment in Air India takes place;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the total number of requests received from AI staff for VRS as on date and the action taken by the Government on these requests;
- (c) whether a section of Air India employees staged protest against the Government's decision to privatize the national carrier saying they were always ready for turnaround and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the manner and mechanism for opting VRS and implementing this scheme?
