4181. SHRI SANJAY HARIBHAU JADHAV:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received complaints against banks on fraudulent withdrawal of money from the customers' accounts using the customers' Aadhaar number linked with their accounts, in the recent past;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the total number of such incidents/complaints received and cases registered including amount involved therein, bank-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to resolve the complaints and to ensure that the amount are returned to the customers and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the remedial steps taken/being taken by the Government to check such incidents in future?
