- the total funds allocated for the survey of archaeological sites in Bihar and to carry out extensive excavation work at the said sites during the last three years;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to formulate any special action plan for excavation in Nalanda and Gaya in Bihar which are considered very rich in archaeological heritage; and
- (c) if so, the funds allocated for the said schemes along with the time frame to start the said work?

- (a) The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has carried the excavation in Bihar at the following sites during the last three years:
 - 1. Rukministhan, South West of Ancient Nalanda University, District Nalanda. Bihar 2014-2015 and 2015-2016.
 - 2. Urain (Uren), Locality Block Surajgarjha (Suryagarha), District Lakhsaraki, Bihar 2016-2017.

Besides Village to Village Survey has also been carried in district Buxar in Bihar.
