- Nineteen Indian Army personnel were martyred in the terrorist attack at Uri Army camp on 18th September, 2016.
- Army has conducted an investigation into the incident and (b) & (c): subsequently, carried out a review of its Standard Operating Procedures and also of security arrangements of its establishments, based on threat assessment and analysis of past incidents. Consequent to the review, suitable drills and procedures have been adopted to counter such threats.
- Indian Army carries out counter-terrorist operations as well as appropriate retaliation to terrorist acts.
