- (a) whether the Government has noticed the rising of unhealthy competitions in the corporate sector, especially in the telecom sector to attract more consumers and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether these types of competitions will affect the sector and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government has any mechanism to control such unhealthy competitions in the sector for its overall development and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c) No rise of unhealthy competition in the telecom sector has come to the notice of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs. Information and complaints received by the Competition Commission of India from time to time are processed as per laid down procedure and is an ongoing process. The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has informed that attracting the customers by adopting illegal offers has not been noticed by TRAI.
