- (a): Coconut Development Board is implementing the following Schemes through which financial and technical support is extended to encourage farmers in the country for coconut farming:-
  - 1. Production and Distribution of Planting Material
    - Establishment of Demonstration cum Seed Production Farms and Commercial Nurseries
    - ii. Establishment of Regional Coconut Nurseries for coconut seedling production
    - iii. Establishment of Nucleus Seed Garden
    - iv. Establishment of Small Coconut Nurseries
- 2. Expansion of Area under Coconut
- 3. Integrated Farming for Productivity Improvement for promotion of scientific management practices i.e.
  - i. Laying out of Demonstration Plots for productivity improvement
  - ii. Establishment of Organic Manure Units

- 4. Replanting and Rejuvenation of Coconut Gardens,
- 5. Technology Mission on Coconut for promoting processing and product diversification,
- 6. Publicity, Extension and Market Promotional activities and Export Promotion Council for exports and
