4326. SHRI KESINENI NANI:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of Grant-in-Aid transferred to Andhra Pradesh under the National AYUSH Mission along with the funds allocated under different activities;
- (b) the number of public health outreach activities organised in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is planning to start Integrated AYUSH Hospitals in the said States and if so, the details of funds allocated and disbursed for the purpose; and
- (d) the number of villages selected under AYUSH Gram in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a): The total fund allocated and approved/released to State Andhra Pradesh under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) since inception of NAM i.e. 15.09.2014 is furnished at **Annexure-I.**
- (b): Ministry of AYUSH approved 39 units of public health outreach activities under NAM to the State of Andhra Pradesh till date. However, as reported by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, the State has not organized the public health outreach activities till date.
- (c): Health is a State subject. Therefore, setting up of Integrated AYUSH Hospital comes under purview of the State Government. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is a provision of financial assistance for setting up of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital. The Ministry has approved two 50-bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals at Kakinada and Visakhapatnam in the State of Andhra Pradesh under NAM. In this regard, Rs. 208.85 lakhs and Rs. 168.85 lakhs have been approved for Kakinada and Visakhapatnam respectively till date.
- (d): As per the information provided by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, the number of villages selected for AYUSH Gram under NAM in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise is furnished at **Annexure-II**.
