- (a) whether the Government has taken note of the fact that a large number of incidents of biting and snatching by dogs and monkeys are being reported in the campus of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any action to curb these activities of dogs and monkeys in the hospital campus; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): One incident each of dog bite and monkey bite has been reported in the campus of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi. Services of experts have been taken to curb such in the campus.
