IMPLEMENTATION OF CYCLONE RISK MITIGATION PROJECT

446. SHRI MANSUKHBHAI DHANJIBHAI VASAVA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project is proposed to be implemented in cyclone prone coastal area of Gujarat;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken in seeking approval of the Competent Authority so far?

 ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) Phase-II has been approved, inter-alia, in the State of Gujarat on 24.07.2015. The NCRMP Phase-II covers the States of Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra and West Bengal to address the vulnerability of the coastal community to cyclone. The project would be completed by 31st March 2020. Project envisages construction of major infrastructure like multipurpose cyclone shelters, access roads, saline embankments and underground cabling.
