## **STRENGTH OF IAS OFFICERS**

## 462. SHRI M. RAJA MOHAN REDDY:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) the sanctioned strength of Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers for the State of Andhra Pradesh as on date;
- (b) the vacancies of such officers at present; and
- (c) the time by which these vacancies are likely to be filled up?

## **ANSWER**

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a)to (c) The total sanctioned Strength of IAS officers in Andhra Pradesh is 211 as on date. As per Civil List 2017, Andhra Pradesh has 170 IAS officers in position as on 01.01.2017 and there is a gap of 41 posts. The occurrence of vacancies and its filling up is an ongoing process. The Government has increased annual intake of IAS officers to 180 during last five years. While distributing the vacancies among various cadres/joint cadres of IAS, deficit in various cadres is also considered. Further, vacancies under promotion quota are filled up on the recommendation of the Selection Committee Meeting for appointment of State Service Officers in All India Services.
