SKILL INDIA SCHEME IN GUJARAT

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the work undertaken through skill India scheme in Narmada and Bharuch districts in Gujarat;
- (b) the number of people from Narmada and Bharuch districts in Gujarat benefited through Skill India scheme; and
- (c) the works proposed to be undertaken in these districts under Skill India scheme along with the time by which these are likely to be completed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

(a) to (c) Ministry is implementing two flagship skill India schemes known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) on pan –India basis to cover the prospective youths. PMKVY enables large number of prospective youths for taking short term fresh training and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) through accredited and affiliated training partner/training centers. This scheme has two components known as Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM). Under CSCM, out of total 56,845 trained candidates in the State of Gujarat, 4,994 candidates trained in the district of Narmada and Bharuch till now. Under CSSM, a target to train 77,824 candidates has been approved for the State of Gujarat covering Narmada and Bharuch.

Under PMKK, Government intends to establish a model aspirational skill centres in every district including Narmada and Bharuch for imparting skill training through PMKVY. Out of 33 districts of Gujarat, 28 districts including Narmada and Bharuch have been already allocated PMKK.
