(c) & (d) During the visit of the Prime Minister to Iran in May 2016, India, Iran and Afghanistan signed an Agreement to establish International Transport and Transit Corridor. The Agreement provides necessary legal framework for the movement of goods and passengers across the territories of the parties (India, Iran and Afghanistan) using Chabahar port, thus providing Afghanistan an assured and alternate access to regional markets through sea.
