## SHORTAGE OF OFFICERS IN NORTH EAST

### **538.** DR. K. GOPAL:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering a new policy to tackle the problem of IAS and IPS officers' reluctance to accept a posting in the North Eastern States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has finalized a draft policy to tackle the problem of shortage of officers in the North Eastern Region by deciding to post officers from other services to the region; and
- (d) if so, the details and the result outcome thereof?

## **ANSWER**

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a)&(b): No, Madam. Out of 90 IAS and 87 IPS allocated to North East Cadres during last 5 years [from Civil Services Examination (CSE), 2011 to CSE, 2015], 87 IAS and 85 IPS have respectively joined the allocated North Eastern State Cadres.

(c)&(d): No such proposal is under consideration.
