**POSTAL LIFE INSURANCE**

- (a) whether the Postal Department is unable to extend the facilities of Postal Life Insurance (PLI) to villagers;
- (b) if so, the number of such villagers which are not able to utilize the services of the PLI and the steps taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (c) whether there is any special provision to provide PLI to the small and the marginal agricultural farmers and if so, the details thereof?
