(a) Three Agreements (Master Agreement, Company Agreement and Contribution Agreement) were signed on 02.12.2014 with international scientific organizations for India's Participation in Thirty Meter Telescope (TMT) project.

An Agreement has been signed by the Department of Biotechnology, with European Molecular Biology Organization (EMBO) and European Molecular Biology Conference (EMBC) on November 9, 2015, by way of which India has become an Associate Member of EMBO.

India-EU (European Union) S&T Agreement, which was signed in 2001, was renewed in 2015 for further five years.

(b) & (c): Does not arise as the agreements are based on the principles of reciprocity and co-funding.
