BASWAN COMMITTEE REPORT

611. SHRI KONDA VISHWESHWAR REDDY:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received the recommendations of Baswan Committee;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the present status with respect to examination of report by UPSC?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (c) : Yes, Madam. The Baswan Committee was constituted by UPSC to comprehensively examine the various issues, raised from time to time regarding the Civil Services Examination, with respect to the eligibility, syllabus, scheme and pattern of the Examination. The report of the Committee has been received by the Government from Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) with its recommendations on various issues.
