EXPANSION OF BHARAT-OMAN REFINERIES

- (a) whether any expansion work has been undertaken in the Bharat-Oman Refineries Limited during the last three years;

(a) to (c): BPCL has reported that Bharat-Oman Refineries Limited (BORL) has undertaken a debottlenecking project to increase the refinery processing capacity from 6 to 7.8 Million Metric Tonne Per Annum (MMTPA) and also to meet the BS-VI product specifications. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 3072 crores. The mechanical completion is scheduled for September 2018. As on June 15, 2017 overall cumulative physical progress of the project stands at 48%.
