# †645. SHRIMATI VEENA DEVI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a large number of train accidents have occurred due to short-comings of railway tracks during the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17;
- (b) if so, the number of such train accidents during the above period;
- (c) whether it has become necessary for the Railways to replace the tracks;
- (d) if so, the length of railway tracks in terms of kilometres that has been considered necessary to be replaced; and
- (e) the length of railway tracks in terms of kilometres that has been replaced during each of the above years?

(a) & (b): Consequential train accidents have occurred due to various factors, one of them is shortcomings of Railway track. Consequential train accidents occurred on account of track shortcomings during the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 are as under:

(c) to (e): Track renewal is a continuous activity, which is undertaken as and when a stretch becomes due for renewal as per criteria laid down in para 302 of Indian Railway Permanent Way Manual (IRPWM) which, inter-alia, takes into account the traffic carried over the track, incidence of rail fractures/failures, wear, age, etc. The details of track renewal targeted and carried out in the last three years are as under:
