ASSISTANCE UNDER IIUS

Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the central assistance allotted and released under the Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme (IIUS) and for the development of export infrastructure and related activities to the East Singhbhum and West Singhbhum districts in Jharkhand;
- (b) whether any efforts have been made to establish some industries based on available raw materials in East Singhbhum and West Singhbhum districts of Jharkhand during the said period; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a): Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) under Ministry of Commerce and Industry had sanctioned a project of 'Auto Cluster, Adityapur' on 13.08.2008 in West Singhbhum district of Jharkhand under the 'Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme (IIUS)' with project cost of Rs.65.63 crore involving central grant of Rs.47.79 crore. Rs.46.35 crore (97% of the central assistance) has been provided to the project. The project at Adityapur was sanctioned with the objective to enhance international competitiveness of the industries located in Adityapur Auto Cluster by providing quality common infrastructure which has benefited them in their overall development including increasing their potential for exports.

(b) & (c): DIPP does not have any scheme to establish industries based on availability of raw material in a particular region or in any State in the country. However, the Department supports development of common facilities in an industrial cluster through Scheme like 'Modified Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme (MIIUS)'. It is the role of State Government and its agencies to take benefit of the Scheme by way of creation of common facilities for benefit of industries based on local raw material located in any particular region.
