FUNDS UNDER PMKSY

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has launched Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana (PMKSY) and allocated funds for Uttar Pradesh thereunder to boost up irrigation facilities in rural areas of the State; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the budgetary allocations made during the last year for each district of the State with special reference to Hardoi and Sitapur?

(a) & (b) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) was launched during the year 2015-16 in the country including Uttar Pradesh, to enhance physical access of water on farm and expand cultivable area under assured irrigation, improve on farm water use efficiency and introduce sustainable water conservation practices, etc.

Under PMKSY-Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP), 4 irrigation projects of Uttar Pradesh have been identified in consultation with state, for completion in phases up to December, 2019. For completion of these projects in a mission mode, funding mechanism through NABARD has been approved by the Government for both Central as well as State share. Details of Central Assistance (CA) released to these projects during 2016-17 are as under:

Further, project proposal for CA release w.r.t. Madhya Ganga Irrigation Project was not received in the Ministry.
