(a): The Ministry of Corporate Affairs has established the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) at IMT, Manesar (Haryana) to function as a Think-Tank, as well as a Capacity Building and Service Delivery Institute to help in Corporate Governance, Reforms & Regulations through synergized knowledge management, partnership and problem solving in a One-Stop-Shop mode.

(b): Since its inception the Government has released Grants-in-aid of Rs 81.89 crore to the IICA, so far, as per the following details:
