SETTING UP OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTES

*25. SHRI GOPAL SHETTY: DR. SHRIKANT EKNATH SHINDE:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to State:

(a) the details of the Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) functioning in the country at present along with the skill trades being taught in these institutes, State/UT-wise including Maharashtra;

(b) the total estimated number of students getting training in these institutes and the existing vacancies in various categories along with the plan to fill up these vacancies, State/UT-wise;

(c) whether the Government proposes to set up new ITIs in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/phase- wise;

(d) whether the Ministry has prepared any fresh plan to upgrade ITIs in the country and if so, the details thereof including integration of ITIs with skill development programmes; and

(e) the details of the amount spent on improvement of ITIs in the country during each of the last three years, State-wise?

ANSWER MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

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(a) to (e) A statement is laid on the table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (E) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 25 ASKED BY HON'BLE M.P SHRI GOPAL SHETTY, DR. SHRIKANT EKNATH SHINDE REGARDING "SETTING UP OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTES" FOR REPLY ON 18.12.2017.

(a) & (b) There are 13912 Industrial Training Institutes(ITIs) in the country(2161 Government and 11751 Private ITIs),affiliated with National Council of Vocational Training (NCVT), wherein training is imparted in 127 designated trades under Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS). The list of ITIs, State-wise/UT-wise including the State of Maharashtra, is attached at **Annexure-I**, and the list of designated trades is placed at **Annexure-II**.

Details of Trades State-wise/District-wise/ITI wise are available in public domain at NCVTMIS portal.

At present 20.36 Lakh trainees are undergoing training in these ITIs. The details of these trainees, category wise, is placed at **Annexure-III**. The demand for a particular course is linked with the market dynamics. DGT is in the process of updating courses at regular intervals. Further, short-term courses provide solution to the lack of demand. Due to dynamics of the market, there is vacancy in few trades. Such trades are revamped into short term courses.

(c) New Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) are set up by State Government/ UT Administration/Society/Trust registered under Indian Trusts Act/ Societies Registration Act etc. The proposals found conforming to National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) norms, are approved for affiliation. Further ,a new policy for affiliation norms is being prepared in consultation with all the stake holders including the State Governments.

Besides, the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship has taken up initiative to set up ITIs in the following schemes:

(i) Skill Development in 47 LWE Districts (Left Wing Extremism) – The scheme envisages establishment of 47 LWE new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in 47 districts affected by Left Wing Extremism in 10 States. The State-wise details of location of new ITIs are at **Annexure-IV**.

(ii) Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in North East States (NE) & Sikkim – The scheme envisages establishment of 22 new ITIs in 8 Northeastern States. The State-wise details of ITIs are at **Annexure-IV**.

(d) The Government of India has approved a new World Bank assisted project Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE). The Project envisages integrating and enhancing delivery quality of 500 ITIs including 100 Private ITIs. The project design encourages the industry led Institute Management Committee (IMC) of ITIs to introduce new long and short term courses to respond to local market needs. The project also interalia covers incentivizing the State/UT governments for policy and regulatory reforms that are aimed at improving the operational environment for ITIs and apprenticeship.

(e) The state-wise details of funds released during the last 3 years for **upgradation of Industrial Training Institute (ITIs)** under following schemes are attached as **Annexure V**:-

(i) **The World Bank assisted Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP):** The scheme, interalia, covered upgradation of 400 Government ITIs in 34 States/ Union Territories.

(ii) **Upgradation of existing Government ITIs into Model ITIs:** 26 Government ITIs have been covered for upgradation into Model ITIs in 25 States.

(iii) **Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States:** The scheme covers upgradation of 20 existing ITIs by introducing of 3 new trades in each ITI and supplementing deficient infrastructure in terms of establishment of new hostels, boundary walls and supplementing old and obsolete tools and equipment in each of 28 existing ITIs in 8 North-eastern States.
