- (a)to(c): Urban Transport is intertwined with Urban Development which is a State subject. Therefore, the responsibility for promoting public transport including city bus service rests with the respective States/Union Territories. Government of India has issued National Urban Transport Policy, 2006 which encourages use of public transport.
- (d)to(e): No, Madam. Citizens have the discretion for choosing the mode of transport for themselves.
