- (a): No, Madam.
- (b): Does not arise.
- (c): First Aid Boxes containing essential drugs and dressing materials are provided with the guards of all passenger carrying trains. In addition, Augmented First Aid Boxes with wide range of medicines, disposable medical material and oxygen cylinder, etc. have been provided with the Train Superintendents/ Guards of Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express trains and nominated long distance trains. Front line staff deployed on trains are also trained in rendering First Aid. The Station Masters of all stations have details of doctors, clinics and hospitals, both Government and Private, in the vicinity of the station, so that their services could also be availed, in emergencies. Ambulance service of both Railway hospitals and State Governments are utilized when required.
