(a) As on 31.3.2017, the number of newspapers/periodicals, TV channels and FM radio stations registered in the country are as under:

(b) Periodicals (Other periodicities)	97,824

FM Radio Stations (as on date)	322

(b) As per available records, the total claimed circulation of newspapers/periodicals during 2016-17 is 48,80,89,490 per publishing day.
