## AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR WATER CONSERVATION

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to organise a national level water quiz in collaboration with the Central Water Commission for children/students to spread awareness regarding various aspects related to water in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the salient features of the said programme?

## **ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION & PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI ARJUN RAM MEGHWAL)

(a) to (c) Yes, Madam. Central Water Commission (CWC), Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation is organizing an 'All India Quiz Competition' on water resources for children/ students studying in recognized schools in class 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> standard.

The nominations of one team, each comprising of two students of 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> standard, were invited from registered schools. In order to give wide publicity to the event and call for nominations, the following steps were taken:

- i. Advertisements in total 20 leading newspapers (15 English & 5 Hindi) covering all the regional centres of Central Water Commission and National Water Academy, Pune.
- ii. E-mails were sent through Kendriya Vidyalya Sangathan, Central Board of Secondary Education& Indian Certificate of Secondary Education.
- iii. E-mails were sent to Principal Secretaries (Education) for all States/ UTs for informing Government aided and other schools.
- iv. Publicity was done by Regional offices of Central Water Commission by e-mails and word of mouth.

Last date for the Registration was 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2017. In all 764 registrations have been received.

The competition is proposed in two stages – tier-I (Preliminary rounds) will be organised at all the 13 Regional Offices of CWC and NWA, Pune in first and second week of January, 2018. The tier-II event, i.e. Finale at New Delhi is tentatively scheduled for first week of February, 2018. Two teams (Winner and Runner-up) from each of the Regional offices and NWA, Pune will qualify to compete in the Finale at Delhi.
