(a) whether the Government has taken note of the survey report on usage of seat belt in India indicating that only 25% of driver's use seat belts in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government proposes strict enforcement of seat belt rule to reduce the rising fatalities/grievous injuries in road accidents; and

(d) if so, the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH L. MANDAVIYA)

(a) & (b) Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has not conducted any survey to check the usage of seat belt in the country.

(c) & (d) The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways administers Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989. However, its provision including enforcement of seat belt are implemented by the State government / UTs.
