- (a) whether Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL) proposes to procure 10000 electric vehicles from Tata Motors Limited to reduce dependence on oil imports and promote power capacity addition in the country thereby enhancing energy security of the country and also reduce in GHG emissions from the transport sector; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the progress made in this regard so far?

(a) & (b): Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL) plans to procure 10000 e-vehicles through demand aggregation. Bids were invited via open tender and under Phase-I, contracts have been awarded to Tata Motors Ltd. for 250 e-cars and M/s Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd. for 150 e-cars which includes five years Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC).

EESL will provide these vehicles on lease to replace the existing petrol and diesel vehicles taken on lease by various Government organizations and charge lease rent from these organizations.
