(a) to(d) This Ministry has initiated several steps to increase expenditure on Information, Education and Communication (IEC). For release of 2^{nd} instalment for the financial year 2017-18, State/UTs have to spend a mandatory 2.5% of available funds onIEC. This Ministry is regularly monitoring expenditure including IEC through a series of meetings/video conferences and during various workshops organised with States/UTs and States/UTs wherein they have to report all expenditure on Online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) as maintained by Ministry.
