be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is generating revenue from the fleet of international passenger and cargo flights using our international airports and air space;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the revenue generated from aviation sector during the last three years, year-wise and expenditure incurred by the Government during the period;
- (c) whether the Government has increased the revenue generation from the Communication, Navigation and Surveillance (CNS) and Air Traffic System (ATS) facilities in the domestic and international airports from the fleet of foreign passenger and cargo flights during the last three years;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the total revenue generated from these airports during the last three years, airport/ year-wise;
- (e) the details of the airlines operating in the country along with their share in the aviation sector, airline-wise; and
- (f) the steps taken by the Government to improve the performance of aviation sector?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) : Yes, Madam. The Airports Authority of India (AAI) generates revenue from the fleet of international passenger and cargo flights towards UDF, PSF, RNFC, TNLC, landing charges, parking charges etc. and generated a revenue of Rs.1562.45 Cr., 1774.52 Cr. and Rs.2056.41 Cr. during the financial years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively. The total revenue generated by AAI during the financial years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 has been Rs.9284.98 Cr., Rs.10824.50 Cr. & Rs.12542.01 Cr respectively, while the expenditure incurred during the above period has been Rs.6493.57 Cr., Rs.7127.15 Cr. & Rs.7984.40 Cr respectively.

(c) & (d) : Yes, Madam. The revenue generated from the Communication, Navigation and Surveillance (CNS) and the Air Traffic Safety (ATS) facilities in the

domestic and international airports from the fleets of foreign passengers and cargo flights has been increased from Rs.1429.29 Cr in 2014-15 to Rs.1887.57 Cr. in 2016-17. The statement of revenue for the last three years airport-wise and year-wise is at Annexure-I.

(e): A statement showing scheduled domestic airlines market share of Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPKM) during 2016-17 is at Annexure-II.

(f): The development of the aviation sector is a continuous process. However, the Ministry of Civil Aviation has released National Civil Aviation Policy (NCAP) on 15.06.2016. The NCAP-2016 covers the broad policy areas, such as regional connectivity, safety, air transport operations, 5/20 requirement for international operations, bilateral traffic rights, fiscal support, maintenance, repair and overhaul, air-cargo etc.
