Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the facility of safe drinking water and toilets has been provided in every village and every house in Vidarbha and Marathwada regions of Maharashtra under the Drinking Water and Sanitation Schemes;
- (b) if so, the region-wise details thereof;
- (c) if not, the number of households deprived of these facilities, State-wise; and
- (d) the time by which these facilities are likely to be provided in these villages/ houses?

## ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI S S AHLUWALIA)

### NRDWP:

a. There are no habitations as uncovered in Vidarbha and Marathwada regions. However, the % of fully covered habitations as per Norms (40LPCD) for Vidarbha region is 90.44% and for Marathawada region is 90.42%.

In respect of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), Sanitation Coverage for Vidarbha region is 89% and for Marathawada region is 89%.
