Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds incurred since 2014 on the information, education and dissemination pertaining to the management of menstrual hygiene, year-wise and State-wise;
- (b) the details of the funds released and incinerators set up in schools from the funds earmarked for Solid and Liquid Waste Management since 2014 onward, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) the details of the funds allocated and utilized for menstrual hygiene management under the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) since 2017 onward, State-wise and year-wise; and
- (d) the details of the monitoring mechanism put in place to ascertain the persons benefited from the above as well as to assess the impact thereof?

- (a) The details of expenditure on the information, education and dissemination pertaining to the management of menstrual hygiene is not available. However, State/UT-wise, Central share expenditure on Information Education and Communication (IEC) under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) since 2014-15 is at Annexure-1.
- (b) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), separate component-wise funds (for e.g. for Solid and Liquid Management) are not released. State Govts take a decision in this regard. Details of incinerators installed in school is therefore not available at Ministry level.
- (c) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), component-wise funds are not allocated and released.
- (d) Ministry does not monitor the details of incinerators installed in school.
