- (a) & (b): No, Madam. Air India had signed a purchase order with Boeing for 68 aircraft in 2005. Air India has already taken a delivery of 65 (27 B787,12 B777-300 ER, 8 B777-200LR and 18 B737). The remaining 3 B777-300ER are scheduled for delivery in January/February, 2018. Further, Air India is in process of completing induction of 27 new A320 (Neo) on dry lease. Out of 27 A320 (Neo), Air India had already inducted 11 A320 (Neo) aircraft.
- (c): Air India has sought loan to finance the delivery of the Boeing Aircraft. The outstanding balance as on 15th October, 2017 is at Annexure-I. (d): No, Madam.
- (e): A statement showing airline-wise number of aircraft available with public and private airlines in the country is given in Annexure-II.
- (f): Government has released its New Civil Aviation Policy, 2016 which includes various steps to meet growing demand of Civil Aviation Sector.
