Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has undertaken any schemes for the promotion of sports in the country, if so, the details thereof for the past three years, State-wise;
- (b) the amount of funds released by the Government to the States including Andhra Pradesh for the purpose;
- (c) the details of projects carried out by the Ministry in the States including Andhra Pradesh during the said period; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to set up an Independent Sports regulator to improve the level of governance and transparency in Sports and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS {COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE (RETD.)}

(a) In order to promote sports through creation of sports infrastructure and conduct of annual sports competitions in the entire country, the

Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports was implementing the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan (RGKA) during the period 2014-15 and 2015-16 and Urban Sports Infrastructure Scheme (USIS) during the period from 2010-11 to 2015-16.

A new Scheme called "Khelo India – National Programme for Development of Sports" was formulated by subsuming the RGKA and USIS and implemented from the financial year 2016-17. The earlier Khelo India Scheme has been revised and revamped during the current financial year 2017-18.

- (b) and (c) Statement showing funds released and details of projects sanctioned to States/UTs including Andhra Pradesh during the last three years are given as Annexure I and Annexure II respectively.
- (d) There is no proposal to set up an Independent Sports regulator to improve the level of governance and transparency in Sports.
