AGREEMENT BETWEEN INDIA AND UK HEALTHCARE

1184. SHRI CHHOTE LAL:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any agreement has been signed between India UK Healthcare and Kings college hospitals, UK for opening of Hospitals in India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the names of the places in the country where the hospitals are proposed to be set up; and
- (d) the likely generation of employment opportunities for doctors, nurses etc. out of such agreement?

(a) to (d): As per the Annexure to the Joint Statement on the UK-India Summit 2015, as informed by Ministry of External Affairs, UK India Healthcare Pvt. Ltd., King's College Hospital and NHS Foundation Trust have signed an agreement to set up King's College Hospital in India. Invest India has informed that Indo-UK Institute of Health projects are proposed in eleven (11) States viz. Andhra Pradesh (Amravati), Maharashtra (Nagpur), Telengana (Hyderabad), Karnataka (Bangalore Rural), Madhya Pradesh (Bhopal), Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow), Punjab (Ludhiana), Gujarat (Ahmedabad/ Gandhinagar), Rajasthan (Jaipur), Haryana (IMT Kharkhoda/Global City Gurgaon), and Assam (Guwahati). Further, Invest India has intimated that around 110,000 direct jobs like doctors, nurses, engineers, construction workers will be created in the 11 medicities.
