1193. DR. KIRIT P. SOLANKI:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to State:

- (a) the total number of anganwadi centres/mini-anganwadi centres presently functional in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government runs any training or skill development programme for anganwadi workers and helpers and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to equip anganwadi centres, located in urban areas to deal with the increasing number of urban poor, such as migrants and slum dwellers and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (Dr. VIRENDRA KUMAR)

- (a) The State-wise total number of anganwadi centres/mini-anganwadi centres presently functional in the country is Annexed.
- (b) Anganwadi Workers (AWWs)/Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs) are provided training by the Anganwadi Training Centres (AWTCs) at the time of their induction and by refresher courses during the course of their service. The AWTCs are run either by the respective State Governments/Union Territory Administrations or by NGO under supervision of respective State Governments/UT Administrations. The Government of India issues guidelines and releases funds to the State Governments/UT Administrations for implementation of the Scheme.
- (c) ICDS Scheme is universal and self selecting with enhanced focus on children below 3 years of age and the most disadvantaged and vulnerable sections of the society, particularly of rural poor population. As per the guidelines of the scheme, migrants and slum dwellers are equally entitled for the services provided under the scheme.
