1208. SHRI NANDI YELLAIAH:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to State:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to deforest the small stretch of forest land to build up six lane clover leaf elevated corridor from Uppal Ring Road to Narapally Gram Panchayat under Ranga Reddy District of Telangana State in view of convenience of people and progressive development of the said areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) No such proposals have been received from the State Government under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of forest land for the project in question.
