(a) to (d): As reported by National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), the position of Gross Non-Performing Assets (GNPA) in respect of State Cooperative Banks (StCBs) and District Central Cooperative Banks (DCCBs) as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 is as under:

| Agency | No of Banks | Gross NPAs<br>(Amount in crore) |
|--------|-------------|---------------------------------|
| StCBs  | 33          | 4985.77                         |
| DCCBs  | 370         | 25547.93                        |

The position of GNPA of Urban Cooperative Banks (UCBs) as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017, as reported by Reserve Bank of India (RBI), is as under:
