# NATIONAL CENTRE FOR DISEASE CONTROL (NCDC)

### 1243. SHRI M. MURALI MOHAN:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the number of National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) branches presently functioning in the country along with the details of employees working in these centres, State/UT, category-wise including Rajahmundry;

(b) whether shortage of Staff has adversely affected the functioning of NCDC and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government is considering to set up NCDC Branches at Visakhapatnam and Amaravati and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to strengthen NCDC and modernise its laboratories/buildings and infrastructure?

### ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PTEL)

(a): A total of 8 NCDC, branches presently functioning in the country. Details of employees working at NCDC, Branches including Rajahmundry is at Annexure.

(b): No.

(c): Yes. NCDC had requested to Government of Andhra Pradesh for allotment of 2-3 Acres of land for establishment of NCDC Branch at state capital.

(d) Following steps were initiated by the Govt. to Strengthen NCDC and modernize the laboratories/ buildings and infrastructure:

- The existing branches are mainly in rented buildings and so it has been proposed to have own land for construction of Govt. buildings for each existing as well as new branches. The feasibility to locate the new branches preferably in State Capitals with local priorities is being explored and will be finalized in consultation with the State authorities.
- Each branch will be provided the manpower support of Experts in Public Health, Microbiology, and Entomology.
- Each Branch will have State-of-the-Art laboratories with sophisticated equipments to provide diagnostic support to the state authorities in diagnosis of emerging and re-emerging diseases.
